PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

Mary Jane Androne (English) participated in a four-week Fulbright Hays seminar in Dakar, Senegal. Her review of Annie Gagiano's "Dealing With Evils: Essays on Writing From Africa" was published in the Spring 2009 issue of the *Journal of the African Literature Association*.

Richard Androne (English) delivered a paper, "'How could this scandal occur?': Henry Adams's 'History' and Garry Wills's Challenge to Adams Scholars," to the Henry Adams Society at the annual convention of the American Literature Association in Boston on May 21, 2009, and on May 24, he became a charter member of the new John Updike Society at its opening session.

Jon Bekken (Communication) spoke as part of two panels at the annual meeting of the Association for Education in Journalism and Mass Communications in Boston in August: on integrating class, race and gender into the communications curriculum and on the challenges facing first generation college students in internships. A paper on the rise and fall of intercraft solidarity in Chicago newspaper strikes from the 1890s through the 1940s has been accepted for presentation at the annual meeting of the American Journalism Historians Association in Birmingham (AL) next month.

Christian Hamann (Chemistry & Biochemistry) presented 3 posters with student co-authors this summer. He and Trevor Hamlin '10 presented a poster at the National Organic Chemistry Symposium titled, "Using Borane, Ammonium and Methylene Substitution to Characterize the Stabilizing Features of a Macrocyclic Sesquiterpene Cation" in June at the Colorado University - Boulder. Chris presented two posters at SYLICCO.09 (Symposium on Learning and Industry targeting Computational Chemistry Opportunities) in July at the University of California - Davis. The first, "Modeling the Conformational Isomerization of an Atropisomeric Farnesyl Transferase Inhibitor", was co-authored with Nicole Reed '04. The second, "Theoretical Hydration Energies of Biologically Relevant α -Ketoamides", was co-authored with Henry Wedler, a UC-Davis undergraduate. This project was executed in the broader context of increasing accessibility in the natural sciences to students with disabilities (Henry has been blind since birth).

Richard Hamwi (Art) has a watercolor collage titled "Blue Mountain Lake" in the Berks Art Alliance Juried Art Exhibit at the Reading Public Museum, now through September 6. He also had a watercolor painting titled "Island Moors" in the Lancaster County Art Association National Juried Exhibit in July. In addition, Richard made a presentation on "The History of Watercolor Painting" as part of the Spring Township library summer reading program.

Karen Jogan (Spanish) received a travel grant from the Embassy of Spain Trade Commission to visit programs teaching Spanish to foreigners in Spain. In June, she visited many universities and institutes throughout the central regions of Spain. In July, Karen was awarded a grant through

Programs in International Education Resources at the McMillan Center, Yale University, to participate in an interdisciplinary seminar “Latin America and the Cold War” at Yale and Georgetown Universities. In August, she was the plenary speaker at the 17th Peru TESOL Convention (Teachers of English to Speakers of Other Languages) focusing on “New Trends in the Teaching/Learning Process: Tips for Technology Integration.” The conference was held at Universidad Nacional San Martin in Tarapoto, in the Peruvian Amazon.

Kate Lehman (Communications) presented her paper "Sexism at Any Altitude? Stewardess Advertising and Second-Wave Feminist Protest" in August, at the Association for Education in Journalism and Mass Communication national conference in Boston. She also conducted archival research in the women's history collection at Radcliffe's Schlesinger Library.

YoungJoo Lee (Fashion) presented design work titled “Reiteration” at the Community of Apparel, Textiles & Design Juried Showcase and Exhibition, American Association of Family & Consumer Sciences 100th Annual Conference & Expo, Knoxville, TN, June 25-28. She will be presenting a paper entitled “Motivating Students to Be More Creative: Using Visual Analysis of Costumes in Film as an Inspirational Source for Apparel Design Courses” and a paper on Creative Teaching, Curriculum Strategies & Best Practices at the 2009 International Textile & Apparel Association (ITAA) Annual Conference in Bellevue, Washington, October 28-31, 2009.
