

Wireless Access Zones on Campus

To be able to use the Albright College wireless network you will need to be in one of the listed coverage areas and be using a computer that supports features from the WPA and 802.1x standards. Please refer to your wireless card manual for information on enabling these resources.

To be able to connect to the wireless network:

- A wireless card that supports **128 bit WEP** and **TKIP** for data encryption.
- Associate to **Albright_College** SSID

IMPORTANT NOTE: *There are no wireless zones in or near any of Albright's residence halls. Internet access in student rooms is provided by Albright's Residence Hall Network.*

Klein Lecture Hall - The Dining Hall - Jake's Place
Main & South Lounges, including Jake's Java

Center for the Arts:

Wachovia Theater

Center for Computing and Mathematics:

First Floor

Gingrich Library:

Lobby and all 3 Library floors

Merner-Pfeifer-Klein Memorial Chapel:

Basement Classrooms

Masters Hall:

All 4 Floors, including the Basement level

Selwyn Hall:

Main Lounge Admission
Day Students' Lounge (Pine Room)

Teel Hall:

First, Second, and Third floors (no Basement service)

Science Hall:

Room 221 (lecture hall), & Third Floor (South Wing only)

Shumo Center:

Includes Lobby and *Pegs, the Café at Shumo*

Outdoor Areas:

The Quad outside the Library & Administration Building is an outdoor Wireless Zone.

Office Coverage locations:

Although offices around campus were not the primary focus of the grant, many were also provided with coverage by the installation.
