Articulation Agreement between Albright College and Chestnut Hill College

This agreement provides Albright College undergraduate students desiring to pursue graduate studies an enhanced graduate articulation at Chestnut Hill College School of Graduate Studies. The agreement provides benefits to Albright College alumni who enroll for graduate studies at Chestnut Hill College, while giving Chestnut Hill College increased access to Albright College's undergraduate population. This agreement encompasses the following graduate programs at Chestnut Hill College, with concentrations, specializations, and locations indicated in each year's catalog of the School of Graduate Studies. The School of Graduate Studies Catalog is updated annually with a target date of July 1; each year's catalog is applicable for the following Fall, Spring, and Summer terms. Any curriculum changes will affect only those students who have not yet enrolled.

Principles of Agreement


1. Chestnut Hill College will waive the one-time application fee (currently \$55) for any graduate of Albright College.
2. Chestnut Hill College will grant eligible Albright students early admission prior to graduation.
3. Chestnut Hill College will offer admitted Albright College graduates a tuition discount of 10% per credit for the graduate programs listed in this agreement (Main Campus and Pottstown Campus only). Eligible students will be responsible for submitting a *Tuition Discount Form* per Chestnut Hill College policy (CHC will provide the form for Albright's website). The discount could be promoted in the Albright brochure, but it would not be listed on the CHC website.
4. Albright College students applying for graduate studies at Chestnut Hill College must meet all admissions requirements set forth by Chestnut Hill College. Chestnut Hill College reserves the right to review each applicant's qualifications and make admissions decisions independent of this agreement.
5. Albright College agrees to waive the annual fee associated with the college's graduate school fair for Chestnut Hill College annually under this agreement.
6. Albright College agrees to provide Chestnut Hill College access to current students and alumni through the following channels:
 - Annual mailer to Albright College alumni through a third party mail house with the scope of the mailer criteria to be flexible to Chestnut Hill College's budget and needs. All printing, postage and mail house costs would be the responsibility of Chestnut Hill College. Albright College would supply the names and addresses to our mail house.
 - Access to annual classroom visit for Organizational Behavior/Applied Psychology cohorts at all ten Accelerated Degree locations of Albright College.
 - Brochure detailing the partnership between the schools to be created by Chestnut Hill College. Albright College to provide logo, assist with content, and incorporate into the Albright admissions criteria for the Organizational Behavior/Applied Psychology, Digital Communications, Information Systems, and Information Systems Management programs. Design and print cost would be the responsibility of Chestnut Hill College.



Both colleges agree to collaborate on a joint press release at the execution of this agreement and will continue to discuss ways to enhance and promote this agreement.


This agreement will be in effect as of the date of its signing. It will be reviewed annually by the appropriate parties at each institution and will be renewed automatically until it is superseded by a new agreement or formally terminated. Either institution may terminate this agreement at any time by written notice at least six months in advance of the effective renewal date. Should this agreement be terminated, it is understood that the termination will not apply to Albright College graduates already enrolled in the Chestnut Hill College graduate programs detailed above under the terms of this agreement.




