Swivl Robot with iPad or iPad Mini



- Do you want to capture video as you walk around a room?
- Do you want to capture video of your student presentations?

Borrow the Swivl Robot and pair it with an iPad mini, Ipad, or your own tablet or recording device, and capture video as you move around the room. The Swivl Robot can sit on a table top surface or fit into a tripod.

<p>iPad Mini</p> <p>The iPad mini's were purchased to be paired with the Swivl Robot. Smaller devices work better in the Swivl.</p>	
<p>iPad 2</p> <p>The iPads can be reserved and borrowed by a faculty member as a group for use in a class or individually as needed for instructional projects.</p>	
<p>Snowflake Microphone</p> <p>These microphones provide a better sound quality for recording. We even have a cable for connecting to an iPad or iPad mini.</p>	
<p>Headsets</p> <p>A headset is nice to use to record videos rather than a separate microphone.</p>	
<p>WebCam</p> <p>Even though a laptop has a built-in webcam, you may need an additional webcam for flexibility in capturing video.</p>	
<p>Wacom Tablets</p> <p>Handheld device with a stylus that allows you to draw or write digitally.</p>
