CALL FOR ENTRIES

Submission is <u>open to all students in all majors</u> currently enrolled at Albright. The exhibit accepts artwork in all media. All submissions must be original and have been created while at Albright since April 2019.

We are excited to be presenting the Student Art Show <u>online</u> this year with the potential to expand our reach to new audiences.

Juror: Ben DeMott, Ceramics Studio Manager, GoggleWorks Center for the Arts, Reading A number of awards will be chosen by the juror.

Exhibit dates: The exhibition runs **Tues. April 28 – Fri. May 15** Albright College website. **Opening**: The Artists Awards announced **Thursday, May 7**, at 5 p.m.

SUBMISSION, SELECTION AND ELIGIBILITY:

- All submissions must be done online: https://www.albright.edu/student-art-show
- Work must be submitted by Tues. April 21, 5 p.m. using the link listed above.
- This online form must be filled out for each submission for the 2020 Student Juried Exhibition, and up to 3 images per submission can be uploaded. You can enter up to five (5) pieces for consideration by the juror. A confirmation email will be sent to you.
- Please make sure the image(s) you submit are <u>clear</u> and a <u>good representation of your work as</u> this is an online format and will be the only opportunity the juror has to judge your work.
- The Student Art Show will be exhibited online this year. <u>Therefore, images submitted for jurying</u> will also represent the artwork to the public.
 - Poor quality images will be rejected.
 - o Backgrounds should be cropped out whenever possible.
 - o If a background is necessary, for example sculpture, it should be fully considered and neutral so as not to distract from the artwork.
 - The image can be a jpeg, png, or tiff. To resize your image, open it in an image processing program such as PhotoShop or GIMP and change the dimensions to between **800–1200 pixels** on the largest side. Do NOT submit thumbnails (less than 800×800 pixels). Change the resolution to **72dpi**. Make sure the resulting file size is less than **5 mb**.
 - Upload videos to YouTube and provide a link.
- All media are eligible for consideration. Not more than five (5) pieces may be submitted by each artist. Works previously submitted to the Juried Student Art Show will not be accepted.
- Exhibition acceptance and awards will be determined by the juror, and all decisions by the juror will be final.

Sales: Sale of artwork is encouraged. Interest in sales will be passed along through the Gallery staff to the artist. Negotiations on prices are strictly between artist and client, but the artist must contact Kristy Kline in person if the sale price and list price differ. The artist will be responsible for shipping artwork to the client. If the work is not priced, we will assume you do not want to sell your artwork.

Agreement: The Freedman Gallery reserves the right to photograph accepted artwork and use it in promotional materials and websites. The submission of artwork to this exhibition will constitute an agreement to all the conditions in these guidelines.

Other information: Please note that the 2020 Annual Juried Student Art Show will be an ONLINE FORMAT ONLY.
