If you are unable to obtain an official transcript, you may submit an unofficial transcript or grade report from the institution. If a copy of your transcripts are on file with Albright College, select the appropriate box below. We will collect this information from either the Office of the Registrar, or from the School of Professional Studies. If you did not earn credit at any of the previous institutions, please continue to Step 3.
