SEMESTER TAKEN

First-Year Seminar (FYS)

International students must complete or be exempted from ALP/SPI 102 before taking FYS 100.

English Composition (1-2 courses)

Placement determines whether a student begins at ENG 101, 101+, or 102; international students must complete or be exempted from ALP/SPI 102 before taking ENG 101.

World Languages and Cultures (2 courses in same language)

Placement determines whether a student begins at 101, 102, 201/203, 202/204 or 301 (202/204 and 301 in Spanish or French only).

Foundations (5 courses)

One from each area below; may count toward a major, at the discretion of the department chair or major coordinator.

Connections (2 courses)

FYS and ENG 102 must be completed before taking a Connections course. At least one (1) Connections course must be designated for **global content**, and at least one (1) must be a **humanities course**. If a single course satisfies both criteria, any second Connections course can complete the requirement. Connections courses **do NOT count toward the major** and **must be from TWO DIFFERENT departments**. Connections courses may count toward a minor.

Synthesis Course (1 course)

At least 3 of 5 Foundations courses and 1 Connections course must be completed before taking a Synthesis course (completion of two semesters of MUS 103, 104 or 105 will count as a Foundations – Fine Arts for this purpose). The Synthesis course **does NOT count toward the major**. The Synthesis course may count toward a minor.

To be completed before junior year (8 for first-year students transferring in spring semester, 6 for sophomore transfers, none for junior transfers)
