

## Tier 0 Connecting Your Laptop to the Projector (VGA)

1. The VGA Cable should be located near the wall plate used to connect to the projection system.
2. Connect the VGA cable to the VGA Port on your laptop.

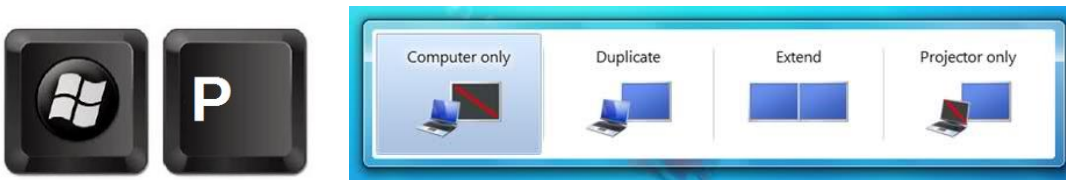


VGA Cable

3. Turn on the projector using the remote control in the room and lower the projector screen.
4. The projector should detect input from your device and display this input on the screen. If the laptop is not immediately detected, use the 'Input' or 'Source' button on the remote control to have the projector detect different channels.
5. If you need to adjust the display options from your Windows laptop press the "Windows" button and "P" button at the same time. You will have options as described below. Duplicating your screen will display a copy of what is on your screen. Extending your screen will allow you to drag windows to the projector screen as though it were a second monitor.



6. If you need to adjust the display options from a MacBook:

- a. press the "Apple" icon in the top left corner.
- b. Select "System Preferences" in the menu.

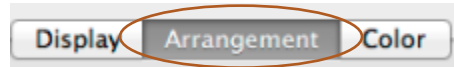

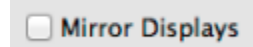
- c. Select Displays.



- d. Click on the Arrangements.



- e. You can change between an extended and mirrored display by clicking "Mirror Displays in the bottom left of the window.



7. When you are finished, please turn off the projector with the remote control and raise the projector screen.

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
